<p>Case 2:</p> <p>Trần Thị Phương</p>	<p>Đức Linh</p>	 <p>The family of Mrs. Phuong's situation is more difficult when her husband died of tuberculosis few months ago. Her health now is not strong enough to work heavy jobs. The whole family with 3 children is depending on her casual job at home as a knitter and very low income from raising pigs. Under support from Sharing International, the family received a micro loan of VND 3 million for raising pigs and 1 educational scholarship for her children. She really needs help from others.</p>
<p>Case 4:</p> <p>Nguyễn Thị Ngọc Anh</p>	<p>Hàm Thuận Nam (HTN)</p>	<p>Under funding from Sharing International, Mrs. Ngoc Anh's got health and accident insurance which help to reduce the worry of treatment and hospital cost in case of diseases. Also, she used the loan to raise chickens, after every 6 months she can increase her family's income if buying the chickens with good price. Beside, her daughters were provided with educational scholarship last academic year and continuing to follow their school this year.</p> <p>She hasn't built house yet. Because of waiting the completion of procedure of land transfer from her own mother.</p>

<p>Case 5:</p> <p>Nguyễn Thị Sang</p>	<p>HTN</p>	<p>Mrs. Sang got health and accident insurance which help to reduce the worry of treatment and hospital cost in case of diseases. Also, she used the loan to grow cassava. Her children were provided with educational scholarship last academic year and continuing to follow their school this year.</p> <p>She is now keeping on her work as a quilter. Because of older age and joint disease she usually takes medicine.</p>
<p>Case 8:</p> <p>Nguyễn Thị Xiêm</p>	<p>Tánh Linh</p>	<p>Mrs. Xiêm got health and accident insurance which help to reduce the worry of treatment and hospital cost in case of diseases. She used the loan to fertilizer the rice field and raise chickens. Also, her eldest child was provided with educational scholarship last 2 academic years.</p> <p>She has just remarried and they built a new small house with good equipped facilities. Now, she can do very well in quilt making.</p>

She didn't show her interest in getting more micro loan, she decided to leave the program. She worried about not affording to repay the loan.</p>
<p>Case 16:</p> <p>Đỗ Thị Hoa</p>			<p>Her son got an educational scholarship supported from Sharing International last academic year and he will keep on his school attending this year. Mrs. Hoa used the loan to raise chicken. Currently her chickens grew up and she can sell chicken for meat in few months. However, because of old age, her health is weaker and weaker.</p>
<p>Case 17:</p> <p>Nguyễn Thị Hoa</p>			<p>Her youngest daughter got an educational scholarship supported from Sharing International last academic year and keeping on her school attending this year. Mrs. Hoa used the loan to raise pigs and fertilizer dragon fruit garden. Now</p>

		<p>the pigs are developing normally and she is harvesting the dragon fruit with good price. Hopefully, the profit from dragon fruit selling can support partly her family expenses.</p>
<p>Case 18: Nguyễn Thị Thanh Hương</p>	<p>HTN</p>	<p>She used the loan to raise chickens and ducks which are developing very well. Last academic year her eldest daughter got an educational scholarship and hoped to keep on her school attending this year. However, the blood cancer prevented her to follow her dream of school. She decided to leave school this new academic year.</p>
